Many years ago I was blessed to have travelled around Britain and Ireland with Trish. We visited many wonderful ancient places of worship, as well as some holy wells. The Celts called these places, "Thin Places". A thin place is where the veil that separates heaven and earth is lifted and one is able to receive a glimpse of the glory of God. There is a Celtic saying that heaven and earth are only three feet apart, but in the thin places that distance is even smaller. The Celts believed that physical locations existed in which God's presence was more accessible than elsewhere, places where heaven and earth seemed to touch, where the line between holy and human met for a moment. I tend to believe that thin places, places where the Spirit of God is at work in a way that we can sense, are not always bound by physicality. Thin places happen every time, every place, where two human beings connect in a way that reflects our God-given humanity in all our brokenness and beauty.
