Condemnation is a tool used by our enemy the devil to blame, criticize and belittle you. Condemnation emphasizes the sins you've done and seeks to make you feel as though you're a failure to God. In John 10:10, the Bible states that the enemy comes to steal, kill and destroy. What better way to go about doing this than to condemn people of their short comings and convince them to be failures? If the devil can condemn people and make them believe their failures, they may withdraw from God and slip back into a world of sin. Although this is the objective of the enemy; there is good news, there's no condemnation to those who are in Jesus Christ (Romans 8:1). God is not a condemning God nor is He a God who condemns you of your shortcomings
