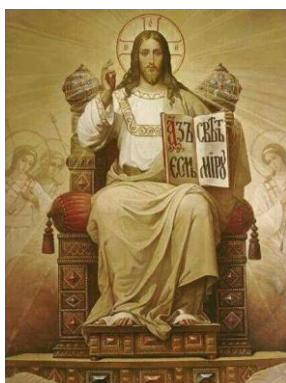

eyewitnesses of his majesty. (2 Peter 1:16)

The Prophecies of Jesus in the Bible

The Bible prophesied hundreds of years before about JESUS CHRIST; that there would be no Israelite king in His day (Genesis 49:10; Ezekiel 21:26-27), that He would be born in Bethlehem Ephratah (Micah 5:2) of a virgin (Isaiah 7:14; Jeremiah 31:22) as both God and Man (Isaiah 9:6); that He would be sinless (Isaiah 53:9), that He would do miracles (Isaiah 61:1), that He would be betrayed by a friend (Psalm 55:12-14; Psalm 41:9) for 30 pieces of silver (Zechariah 11:12-13), that He would be arrested (Isaiah 53:7-8), that His disciples would forsake Him (Zechariah 13:7), that He would be accused by false witnesses (Psalm 35:11), that His hands and feet would be pierced in crucifixion (Psalm 22:16), that He would be crucified with criminals (Isaiah 53:12) and make intercession for the transgressors, that there would be darkness over the land (Amos 8:9), that He would die (Daniel 9:26; Isaiah 53:12), that He would trust His Father (Psalm 31:5), that His side would be pierced (Isaiah 53:5; Zechariah 12:10) and that His heart would be broken (Psalm 22:14), but not one bone of His would be broken (Psalm 34:20), that He would be buried in a rich man's tomb (Isaiah 53:9), and that He would Rise again From Death (Psalm 16:10) on the 3rd Day (Hosea 6:2).
