Working Bee Details



We will attempt to get much of the work done on the first working bee Saturday 19 August at 9am, and on the 26th Aug 9am we will finish off any uncompleted work. On the Friday 1st Sep and Sat 2nd Sept will be the moving of church furniture etc and getting the church ready for its reopening service the next day Sunday 3 Sep

The **FRONT PORCH FLOOR** needs the old grey 1980's vinyl lifting and removing, then the matai wood flooring underneath sanded then coated with polyurethane. Does anyone want to assist with this work? You will need to have scrapers, an electric sander (vicar has one to borrow) sandpaper and brushes etc. This work should be done on the <u>5th and/or 12th</u> <u>August</u> so it can dry before the working bee. If you are wanting to do this work, and feel confident to do it, please see or call the vicar 02741300 or 07 8492761 evenings

For the working bee, we also need two people to each oversee and take on the pickup, purchase, and work, for the **Wet & Forget**, and the **Rug Doctor** hire. Any cost will be reimbursed. Please see the vicar if you want to oversee this

Working Bee Exterior Work:

- Clean out driveway gutter grill by front gate and clean driveway of leaves and mud with spade and wash off with a hose
- Wet & Forget to spray on lichen growing on asphalt, vestry steps that is covered in moss, and both front metal gates that are covered in lichen. Wet & Forget from the Base \$100
- Clean the St Marys sign from algae
- Trim the 3 camellias and the in-between roses, also removing a wild tree growing out from a camellia, and any weeds
- Paint the iron strap hinges and door knockers etc black on both external doors (Vicar has black paint and brush)
- Cleaning of exterior windows

Working Bee Interior Work:

- Place furniture/pews back.
- Vacuum carpet
- Clean out bathroom/toilet (later to take Christmas decorations to the Old School room for storage?)
- Vacuum old Dossal then store (in the Old School room later on?)
- Dispose of rubbish/junk on top of vestry cupboards
- Clean and disinfect kitchen cupboards, disposal of old plastic cups
 etc
- Dust altar, pews, window ledgers and all surfaces.
- Cleaning of interior windows
- Beeswax clean altar and pews (towards the end of the working bee)
- Rug Doctor clean of carpet (\$50 machine hire rate for overnight and \$23 cleaning product - \$50 bond back) THIS SHOULD BE ONE OF THE LAST JOBS OF THE WORKING BEE
