Advent is a time to prepare for Christ's coming. Advent looks both back to Christ and forward to Christ; to prepare in expecting the Christ Child, and prepare that Christ will one day soon return again. A few weeks ago, we delved into the parable of the 10 maidens – 5 were foolish, and 5 were wise. Jesus concluded his parable to keep watch. This Sunday's gospel Jesus also repeats: "...Keep watch."
