Homily: "Gaudete/Rejoice!" Rev David Smithson

Morning Tea: Majella

Today we're celebrating the Third Sunday in Advent, and it's traditionally known as 'Gaudete' Sunday, from the Latin word for 'rejoice or joy'. In our readings for this Sunday morning, the theme of Joy is strong. In our NT reading Paul says 'Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, Rejoice' And in our Old Testament reading we hear Zephaniah – a prophet who for most of his time had been foretelling doom and gloom judgement against Jerusalem – suddenly finishing his prophecy in v 14 with *"Sing and shout for Joy, people of Israel. Rejoice with all your heart Jerusalem!"*
