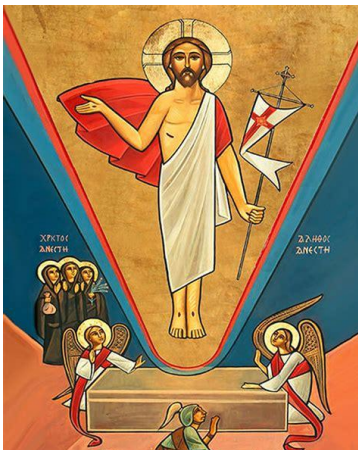
10am Easter Holy Communion Service

Homily: "Shock and Awe" Rev David Smithson

On Sunday we celebrate that the darkness of the Tomb is pushed aside by the light of the Resurrection of Christ, in which we say "He is Risen – He is Risen indeed!"
