What is God's will? It's a very important question! When we are faced with conflicts in our lives, how does God want us to respond? God is the one who made us and knows us. What does God want? And how can we know what God wants? How can we seek to be filled with the knowledge of his will in "*all the wisdom that his Spirit gives?*" (Colossians 1:9). One way is to look at Jesus Christ. 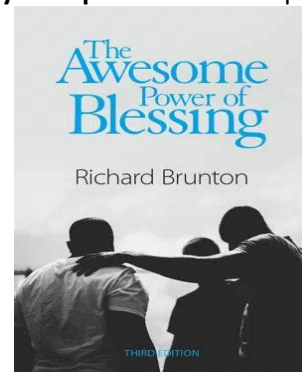
