This Sunday's New Testament reading finds Paul in Athens. Up to now, he'd preached to the Jews to accept Jesus as the Promised Messiah of the Jewish faith. That got him into trouble time and again. While some believed, others were openly hostile. They'd drive him out of town, sometimes throwing stones at him. But not in Athens. Here Paul speaks to learned, well-educated, sophisticated scholars of the day. They listen. They don't argue with Paul. If anything, they're curious to know more, but most really have no interest whatsoever in what he says...

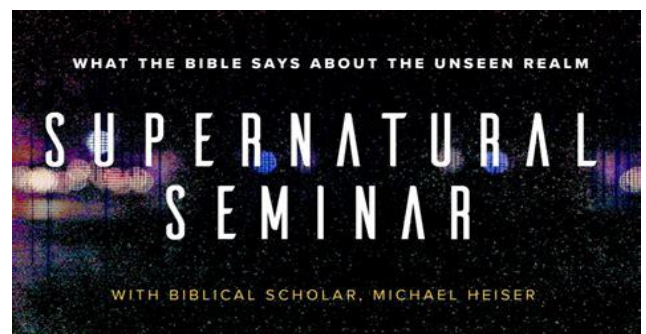
