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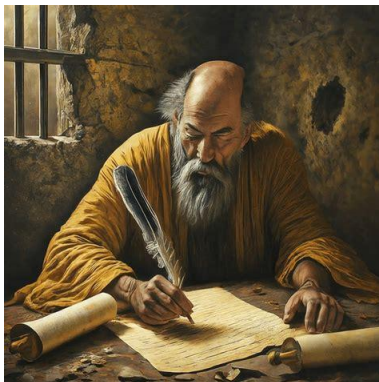

Homily: "For What is Life?" Rev David Smithson

"For what is life? To me, it is Christ. Death, then, will bring more". Paul wrote those words while he was in prison. Paul was not writing from a comfortable home or taking it easy in life.
